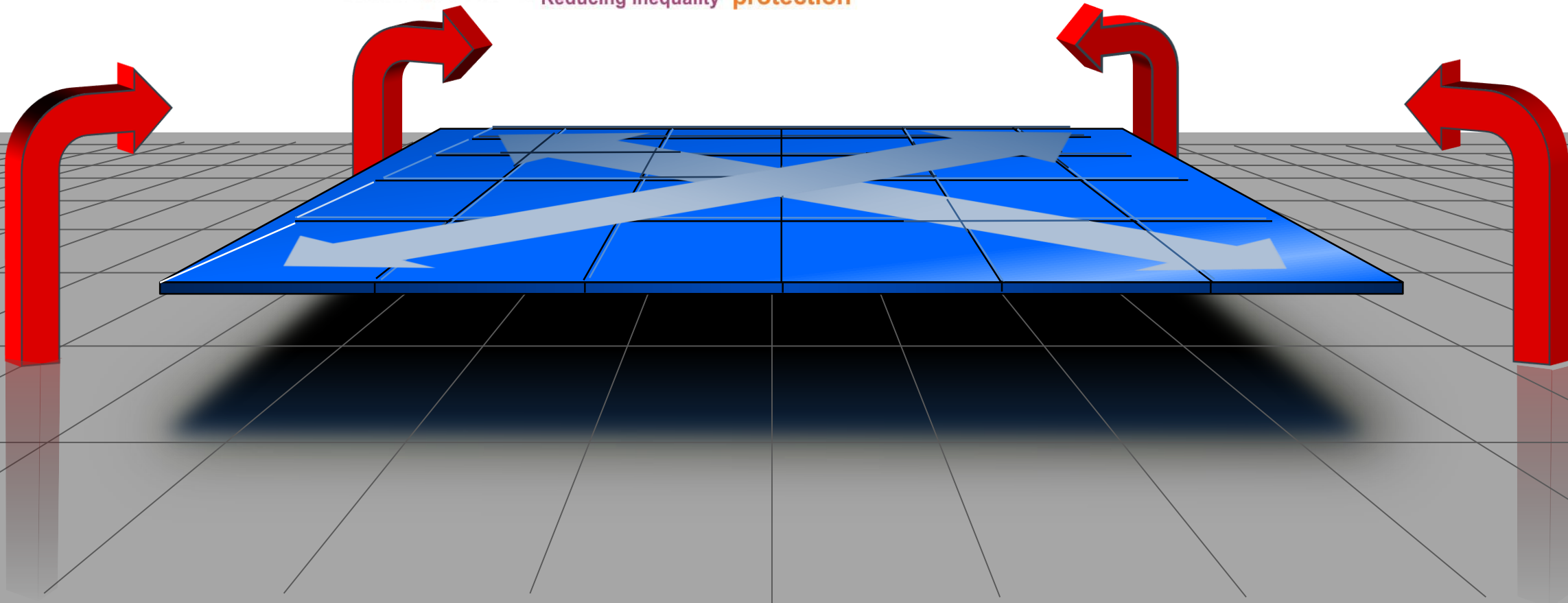

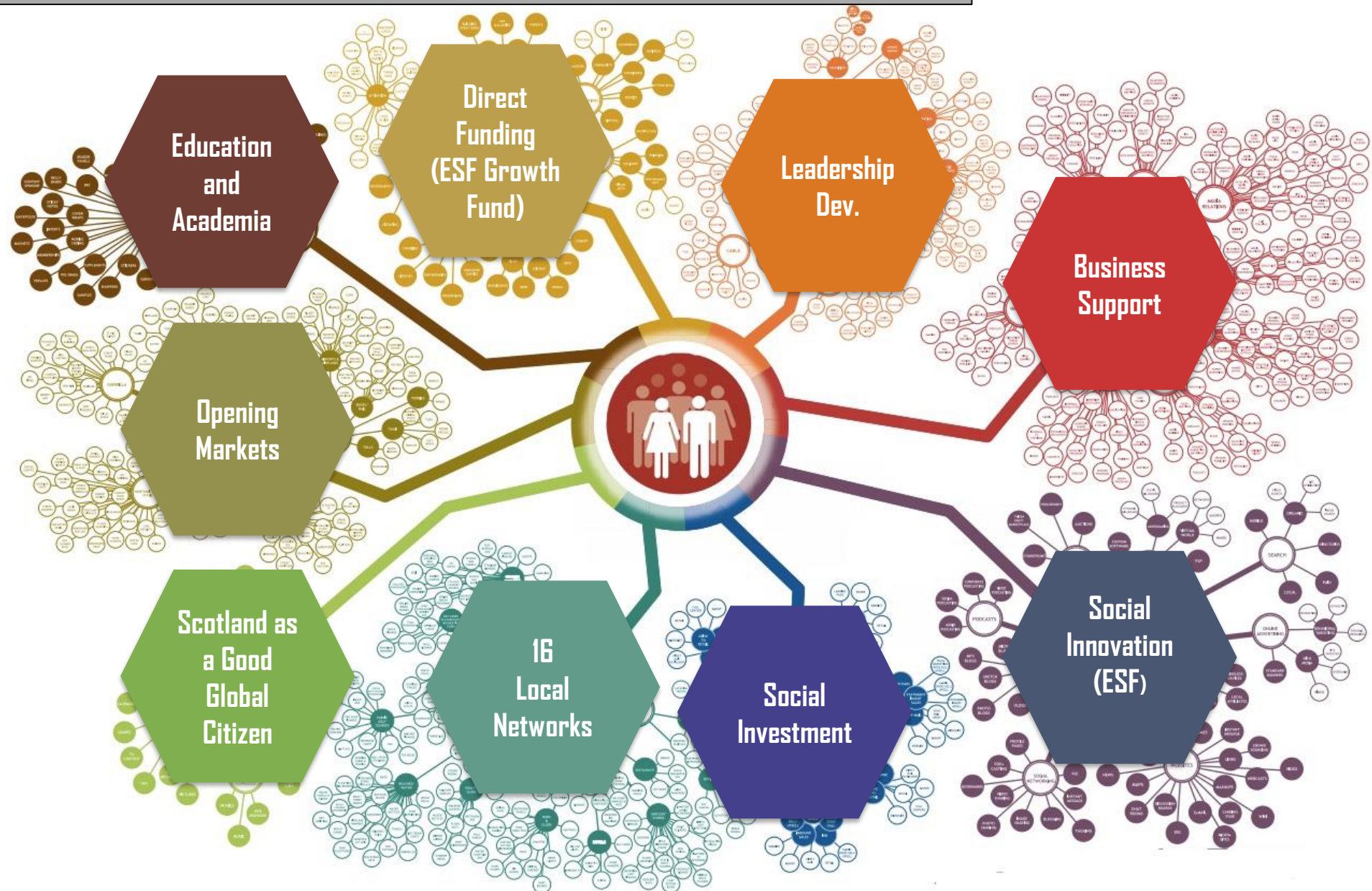

- Similar themes to national strategy
- Targeted to develop the local economy
- Overseen by SE Board (council, sector, academia)
