




- Co-produced between Govt and the sector

Glasgow City SE Strategy 2018-28

- Scotland's largest city (c600,000 citizens)
- Building on a 'cooperative council' to promote and support co-operative, mutual and social enterprise business models in the city via Co-operative Development Unit.
- Strategy co-produced by council and sector/GSEN
- Similar themes to national strategy
- Targeted to develop the local economy
- Overseen by SE Board (council, sector, academia)
